





## EVALUATION REPORT OF CRS WORKSHOP 6 - IN TARNOW

CRS evaluation workshop "The nature and mode of action of the institutions involved in support for children and youth experiencing homelessness in Poland" was held on 10.23.2014. These involved 28 people. At the end of the workshop, participants completed a questionnaire, which assessed the pertinent knowledge, and practical skills. Answered 6 questions, 3 closed questions and 3 open.


The first question was to show whether it was worth it to participate in this meeting: 8 people answered that yes; 11, so that rather; 7 people chose the answer is difficult to say, and two people have stated they would rather not.



In the second question, the participants rated the level of all the presented content: 9 people definitely highly rated the level of presentation; 8 people said that the presentation was rather at a high level; 5 people had no opinion on this subject and chose the answer is difficult to say, 6 persons rather low rated the way their contents.



The third question to answer was whether the training, participants gained new skills / knowledge?: 15 people answered that yes; 4 people have stated that they do not; 9 people were not able to decide and chose the answer is difficult to say.



The fourth question, the participants evaluated the effectiveness and efficiency of the meeting: the opinions of the evaluators were divided. Some said that the meeting was of a very high level,



efficient, effective, satisfactorily, others that sufficiently low, rather low, 6 people had no opinion on the subject.

The fifth question was to identify what is most interested participants during the meeting: half of the respondents assessed very well presented manner and form messages, multimedia presentations and the effectiveness of the knowledge, two people had no opinion on the subject and wrote hard to say, 14 people left the question unanswered.

In the sixth question, the participants had to write what was the least interesting at the meeting: one person wrote that the lack of examples from life, three did not like the form of communication, the two did not have reservations, one is hard to say, and 21 people have written nothing, apparently manner and the contents of the knowledge they satisfied the.

At the end it should be considered whether the institutions that have to deal with support for children and youth experiencing homelessness in Poland actually fulfill its role, as in many cases do not even know. Not everyone wants to use, even being in difficult conditions with the help of MOPS-in, or GOPS-in, sometimes that information reaches those individuals, through cooperation with schools and centers of assistance. Surely this is a difficult subject, the more that this is the most vulnerable and dependent on others lives.
