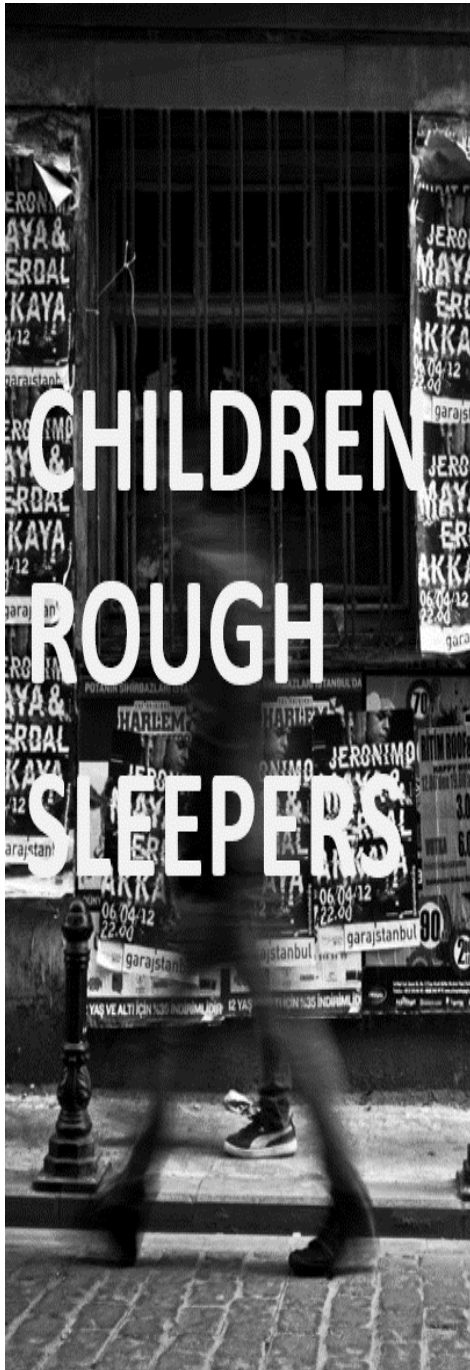

Symmetries in collaboration with the Faculty of Social Sciences of Talavera de la Reina, University of Castilla La Mancha, organized the 2014 CRS WORKSHOP with the presentation of the Research Report on situation of children and young people in situations of extreme vulnerability in Spain and Europe, from a specific approach of those who sleep in the street, who do not have a home, living in unhealthy or unsafe or are victims of exploitation, abuse or other violence in the streets housing.



Goals:

1. Analyze and discuss the problems of children and young people under 18 living in extreme vulnerability, homeless, poor housing, unsafe housing or victims of exploitation, abuse or other street violence. Analyze and discuss government policies and social organizations, their coordination addressing these issues.
2. Share with other professionals of government and private organizations the knowledge and experience of this reality.
3. Transfer good practices.
4. Discuss solutions or recommendations of Justice Commission of the European Union to improve policy initiatives for help and protect children in vulnerable situations.
